May as a month reminds us of Spring time and flowers, warmer weather moving in to thaw the cold of winter, birds chirping as they return from their winter absence. Bright colors and new life spring forth all around us, so it is only fitting that May also gives us Mother's Day to celebrate. We celebrate and honor our mother's in a variety of ways with bouquets of flowers, balloons, chocolates and gifts. We look for many ways to show our Mother's just how much they mean to us and how we are all blessed because of them. Pastor Sam Crabtree has a different perspective on Mother's Day. He says:

"Mother's Day is not primarily about being a mother and <u>receiving</u> honor, but thanking God for the mother he gave you, and <u>giving</u> honor. The people giving honor should also include all moms. Persons receiving honor as moms should also be giving honor for their own Godgiven mothers."

As we strive to honor our Mother's on this day, we must also honor God who gave us this wonderful gift of a mother. And if you are a mother, along with receiving honor on your day, you should also consider how you can give honor to others as well. For many of us our hearts soar in thanksgiving to God when we think of our mothers, grandmothers, and any woman who has been loving and motherly towards us. Their tender love and care are an example towards us that is unparalleled. The Gospel itself is encapsulated for us in the love of a Mother towards her children. This giving and selfsacrificing love is the same love Christ has for us, and the closest example we all have of this love comes from our Mothers. This is why Proverbs reminds us that for a godly mother "Her children will rise up and call her blessed." (Proverbs 31:28)

The great English Baptist preacher Charles Spurgeon, writing in his *Early Religious Impressions*, not only says "Fathers and mothers are the most natural agents for God to use in the salvation of their children" but in particular he celebrates his mother:

"I am sure that, in my early youth, no teaching ever made such an impression upon my mind as the instruction of my mother, neither can I conceive that, to any child, there can be one who will have such influence over the heart as the mother who has so tenderly cared for her offspring."

Although Motherhood is a wonderful gift and an honor, there are many women who have not been mothers, or might not have had a healthy relationship with their mother and Mother's day might not be such a celebrated time. If a mother has faced the grief of losing a child this might be a difficult and sad time as well. I hope that in addition to giving honor to our Mothers we also recognize and encourage everyone who has been motherly and loving towards us, despite the fact that they are not mothers biologically. Their example of love and care and self-sacrifice should be enough for us to honor them and thank God for them and their influence on our lives.
