As the weather warms up and Summer is fast approaching, many students are ending the school year and a lucky few are celebrating their graduation. Few occasions are more anticipated than graduation. We invite our loved ones, wear clothes we never wear anywhere else, the higher your degree the sillier the hat you have to wear, and we take lots and lots of pictures. It is a time of celebration and signifies a completion and an accomplishment. It ends one part of a person's life and leads into a new chapter.

During commencement there is usually a keynote speaker who addresses the graduates and reflects upon their accomplishments and encourages them in what they might accomplish in the future and bestows upon them some words of advice. I imagine the Apostle Paul giving a similar kind of speech as he writes to the churches in his epistles and gives them his parting words. In Colossians he writes to the church and says,

(2 Timothy 3:16-17)

The goal is similar, God wants to train us and equip us through His holy word to be fully equipped to handle life. We must know His word and what it says specifically about how we should live, and by studying it we gain the principles and wisdom to discern and decide how to deal with situations that aren't explicitly covered in the Bible.

God wants us to be mature and equipped believers and that comes from our devoted study of His Word and His Gospel. His promise to us is that if we are faithful, He will surely be faithful. Because of Christ our graduation gowns will be white as snow and our heads will be adorned by Christ's crown and His goodness.
