Synopsis of the Armenian Sermon

On that first Whitsunday, in year 33 A. D., the followers of Christ experienced the powerful influence of the Holy Spirit. Their lives were transformed. They became bold witnesses for Christ, three thousand persons joined the church, laying down the foundations of the Christian Church. The Holy Spirit broke down the walls between believers - - racial, educational, economic walls came down. In spite of all their differences, the early Christians felt like brothers and sisters of a large family.

The outpouring of the Holy Spirit also empowered the Church. The members of the early church supported each other spiritually, morally and even financially. Although they were poor and had no ecclesiastical skills, God still blessed them in every way.
