SYNOPSIS OF THE ARMENIAN SERMON

In Matthew Chapter 25 Jesus teaches through three parables. A while back we covered verses 1-13 that teach readiness, this week we will study verses 14-30 that teach productivity, and next week we'll look at verses 31-46 that teach accountability.

The parable in 14-30 is called the parable of the talents, and it teaches that while we should always be ready for the return of our Lord, we need not be idle in the meantime. We are exhorted to be busy and productive.

Talents are abilities, skills, intelligence, or gifts that are bestowed on the believer by God. All people have talents; some have more than others. God expects us to be using them for His glory, and in this parable we see that God will judge our faithfulness in using these talents. Not everyone has the gift of teaching Sunday school, singing in the choir, visiting the sick and elderly, or playing music, but for sure everyone has some talent (s) that they can use in God's service.

What gift(s) do you have that you are not using? Look for ways to use your gift(s). You will be a blessing for the church and God will bless you.
