## SYNOPSIS OF THE ARMENIAN SERMON

information with your name to Alice Kakousian or Frances Garabedian.

In illustrating his teaching on the subject of prayer, Jesus in **Luke 11:5-13**, gives his disciples some examples to show the Father's willingness to hear and answer prayer.

The main lessons from these illustrations are:

- **Vv. 5-8** teach that if a friend is willing to help his neighbor because of his boldness in asking, how much more is God willing to hear and help His children.
- **V.9** teaches that we should not get tired or discouraged in our prayer life. God answers our prayer according to His timing. Sometimes it is right away, and at other times it might take some time.
- **V.10** teaches that God not only hears our prayers, but He also answers them by giving us what He knows is best for us. Sometimes a "no" answer might be the best answer for us.
- **Vv.11, 12** teach that God will never deceive or mock His children by giving them something harmful instead of what they asked for. The conclusion (v.13) is that, if sinful human fathers give good things to their children how much more can we count on our heavenly Father to give us His Holy Spirit, who will help us in our prayers.
