Synopsis of the Armenian Sermon

In Luke 13: 22-30 while Jesus is traveling towards Jerusalem and his ultimate suffering and crucifixion, someone in the crowd asks him this question, "Are only few people going to be saved?" Jesus' answer is that the door to heaven is open now but some day will be closed. Throughout history God has given humans opportunities to be saved, but often they have rejected it. The door is narrow according to Jesus because there is only One Way to be saved and that is through Jesus Christ who is the Only Way to the Father. For many people back then and more so today, to accept Jesus' biblical claim that He is the only way is very narrow and unacceptable. But the Jesus in Matthew 7:13, 14 says, "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only few find it." Jesus continues and says that once the door is shut there will be no more any opportunity to get in. The people in the parable "protested that they had lived on intimate terms with him. But Jesus was not moved by these pretensions." The problem with many people is that they want to come to God through their own way. There way is the way of formality, without faith, ritual without reality, and religion without righteousness. They do not want to repent, ask for forgiveness of their sins, and embrace Jesus by faith that is God's way. But want to trust in their own good works and religiosity. This Jesus says will lead to destruction.

Friends, the door to heaven is open for now and for everyone. But don't wait for tomorrow and don't depend on a religious experience – accept Christ as your personal Savior today.
