Synopsis of the Armenian Sermon

In the parable of Matthew 21:28-32, a father of two sons orders them to go work in his vineyard. The first refused, but later changed his mind and obeyed his father. The second agreed, but later changed his mind and did not go work in the vineyard. When the religious leaders were asked which son did the will of his father, the answer was the first.

God the Father sent John the Baptist to pave the way for Jesus and his ministry of salvation. Tax collectors and harlots, who were considered sinners and looked down on by society, are like the first son. At first they might not have been attracted to John's preaching, but later many of them did repent and believe. The religious leaders on the other hand, often professed to approve of John's preaching, but never really trusted Jesus.

Many today also approve of the Christian faith in general, yet they never fully trust Jesus. Many do not accept Christ because it is too hard for them to admit that they are sinners and need to repent. Others have doubts about the truthfulness of the Bible and that Jesus is really the *Only Way* to the Father. What about you? Are you like the first son or the second?
