Synopsis of the Armenian Sermon "God Is Faithful"

(I Corinthians 1:1-9)

The church is often criticized for many things. It is criticized for its lack of love. It is criticized for being hypocritical. It is criticized for not being spiritual enough, or for having problems, and the list goes on. Even though the church might have many weaknesses, this should not discourage us from regularly attending church, nor become the cause for totally abandoning it, as some have done.

The above-mentioned passage from the letter to the Corinthian church gives us answers to what our attitude should be like. This Corinthian church had many problems, and Paul is writing in response to some of the news that had reached him about them. Paul is able to give thanks to God for them because of God's character. God will always remain faithful to His promises to make His people perfect despite their imperfection. God through His Son Jesus has given His people the necessary gifts to remain strong until His Son's return. God Himself was going to keep them until Jesus' return. We also should be thankful, and should be praying to God for His church and its ministry in the world. The church is not perfect, and will not ever achieve perfection in this world, but God is constantly working on perfecting His people. This process should not be left entirely to God, but we, as Christians who have been blessed by the gift of the Holy Spirit, should be on an upward journey towards perfection and holiness.

God is faithful; let us also be faithful to His church. Let us pray and work to improve and encourage the ministry of the church, because it is God's tool in this world. It is through the church's ministry of evangelism and witnessing that God works to change and transform people.
