### Synopsis of the Armenian Message

Today is *Translators* Sunday. What we mean with "*The Translators*" is the group of learned people under the leadership of *St. Mesrop Mashtots* who invented the Armenian alphabet, and translated the Holy Bible to the Armenian language. *St. Gregory the Illuminator* had brought the light of the gospel to king *Trdat* who converted to Christianity and declared it the official state religion. But much of Armenia was still under the darkness of paganism at this time. The translation of the Bible was the crucial step that was to help bring the light of Christ into the lives of the Armenian people.

The psalmist in psalm 119:105 speaks of the Word of God as a lamp and a light that illuminates his way. God's Word is the means that God uses to reveal His will to us. Jesus came as the incarnate Word of God. He is the light of the world that gives life. By reading, studying, and applying God's Word to our lives, we will come to know God and experience His salvation, our walk will be illuminated and directed by His light, and we will walk in His ways and live lives pleasing to Him.

The Armenian people should ever be grateful for the *Translators'* work, which made us one of the earliest people to have the Bible in our own language. Even today many language groups still do not have the Bible in their own languages.
