Synopsis of the Armenian Message (John 1:4, 5, 9; 8:12)

Light can be divided into two categories, artificial light and natural light. Artificial light comes from artificial sources, such as electricity, oil, or batteries. Natural light comes from natural sources (God's creation), the sun, the moon, or the stars. This fact is true in the spiritual realm also. Light can come from artificial sources like religion and good works, or it can come from a natural source. According to John, that source is Jesus who came as the light. There is but one source for real spiritual light, and that source is Jesus Christ.

Jesus disperses the artificial lights. To be able to recognize what's real and what's artificial, we need Jesus' light in our lives. His light can give us the wisdom and the guidance necessary to find our way in this life. Just like everything shines more brightly under the light of the sun, so it is with our lives. When Jesus' light is in us, we will shine more brightly.

Jesus disperses the darkness of sin. Jesus is for sin that which light is for darkness. Jesus is the absolute opposite of sin. Where He is present, sin cannot be present. Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life" (8:12). There is no sin in this world that the light of Jesus is unable to disperse. The problem is that some people choose to walk in darkness rather than walk in the light of Jesus.

Jesus can bring light to your life if you will allow Him to come into your heart. He came into this world to bring light into our lives. Why don't you invite Him in this Christmas?

May the light of Christ shine brightly in your lives this Christmas, in the coming year and always.
