### Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(Revelation 2:12-17)

The third letter is addressed to the church at Pergamum, which means high tower. The speaker Christ, is identified here as the one who has the sharp, double-edged sword. In Hebrews 4:12, we are told that God's Word is sharper than a double-edged sword, and it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Here we have Christ pictured as holding the Word of God by which He will judge people. The speaker knows that these believers live in a city that was the headquarters of the emperor-worship, and that is why it is identified as "Where Satan has his throne." Christ commends this church for being loyal and remaining faithful to Him, despite their persecution and the fact that they lived in a city where Satan lived. But the verdict against them is that they are divided and they have allowed false doctrine and teachers to infiltrate the church. The prescription to correct the problem is to repent and adhere to His Word. The promised reward for the overcomer is hidden manna, a white stone, and a new name. John Stott says, "The hidden manna is Christ. The new name is Christ. We shall feast on the manna and comprehend the name... Those who do not deny Christ's faith will be satisfied by the hidden manna. Those who know in part shall know also as they are known. Those who see Christ now in a mirror dimly shall see him face to face."

The message to the church today is to hold on to the truth of Christ. It is often very tempting to compromise the truth of the gospel to appeal to the culture, yet Christ commends these Christians for "remaining true to His name, and not renouncing their faith in Him."
