### **Synopsis of the Armenian Message**

(Romans 8:34-39)

Vartanants is the commemoration of the battle that took place in 451 A.D. between the Armenian forces under the leadership of Vartan Mamigonian and the Persian forces. But Vartanants, is more than just another battle in the history of a certain people, in this case the Armenian people. It is a battle that shaped the history of the Armenian people and nation. The Leaders of the Armenian people of the day were put in a very difficult situation. King Hazgard of Persia gave the Armenians one choice, deny Christ and your Christian faith and become Zoroastrian. The Armenian leaders responded by saying, "No one can shake us from our faith." This reminds us of the words of Romans 8:35, "Who will separate us from the love of Christ?" and the answer to this question is in verses 38 and 39. For this decision the Armenians paid dearly. The Persian king sent some of his best forces to fight the Armenians, who on that day lost the battle, and also Vartan and 1035 others with him were martyred.

The victory for the Armenians was that a few years later the Persians changed their stance against the Armenians and gave them the freedom to practice their Christian faith.

The question for all of us today is how much do we love Christ? Are we willing to give up those things that separate us from Him?

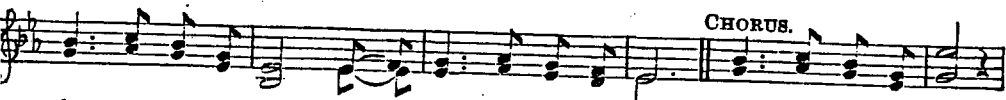
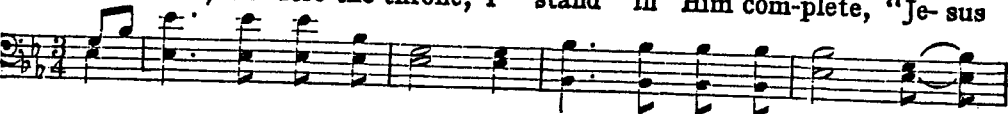

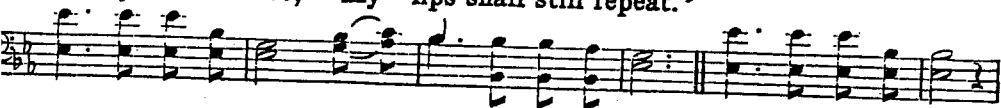
