Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(Revelation 3:7-13)

The sixth letter is addressed to the church in Philadelphia, which means, "love for the brethren. The speaker, Christ, is identified as "him who is holy and true, who holds the key of David. What he opens no one can shut, and what he shuts no one can open." This speaks of Christ's absolute sovereignty, authority and control. Christ knows that this church even though weak, yet, has remained loyal to him, faithful to the gospel, and endured persecution and hardship patiently. He who holds the keys has opened before them a door for evangelism, salvation, and service. He promises them two things. First, that some of their enemies will come to acknowledge His love to them, which means that they will be saved through the open door of evangelism and salvation. Second, they will be spared the end times tribulation period. Those who persevere and overcome will have three names written on them: the name of God, the New Jerusalem, and His name. This means that they will be identified as belonging to God and His Son, Jesus, and their city is the heavenly Jerusalem.

The message for the church of today is that even though some doors in some places might be closed, many doors for evangelism are still open. We need to make the most of the opportunities that Christ opens before us for spreading the good news of salvation.
