

## Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(Revelation 3:14-22)

The seventh letter is addressed to the church of Laodicea. The speaker, Christ is identified as the "Amen, the faithful and true witness, the ruler of God's creation." This means that He fulfills all of God's promises. Christ knows that they are rich and affluent, yet they are lukewarm, which means that they lack enthusiasm, and wholeheartedness. He counsels them to repent and to come and acquire from Him genuine faith and righteousness. Christ is standing at the door and knocking and waiting for those who will open the door of their hearts and invite Him in for true fellowship. Those who do that are promised to sit with Him on His throne and rule with Him. The message for the church of today is that Christ is looking for genuine followers. No nominal, skin-deep religiosity will cut it. Are you wholeheartedly with Him, or are you sitting on the fence? The warning for lukewarm Christians is that "He is going to spit you out of His mouth."

### Rev. Daniel Albarian

Pastor Daniel Albarian was born in Beirut, Lebanon where he attended and graduated from Central High School. After his graduation from High School, he immigrated to Canada and got married to Suzan in 1977. He attended College in Canada and graduated with Bachelor of Arts degree from York University.

In 1981, Suzan and Daniel moved to California where he attended Fuller Theological Seminar and graduated with Master of Divinity degree.

Pastor Daniel became the administrator of Charlotte and Elise Merdinian Armenian Evangelical School for two years after which he became the pastor of the Armenian Evangelical Church of New York for three years. He then moved back to California and served in Downey at Immanuel Church as its Associate Pastor. In 1990, Pastor Daniel, with God's help started the Armenian Christian Fellowship of Orange County and served there till 1998.

The Lord took him to Glendale in September of 1998 to minister in the Christian Outreach for Armenians Church. Since then he has been serving the community of Glendale/Burbank.

Pastor Daniel and his wife Suzan have been married for almost 30 years and they are blessed with three children: Priscilla married to Cassidy, Paul and Daniel John.
