Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(Habakkuk 1:12-2:20)

Habakkuk's second complaint is in response to God's answer that He is using Judah's godless enemies to punish them. The prophet is even more baffled by God's answer. He complains to God that he cannot understand how God can punish them by using a people worse than them. His argument is based on the fact that God is holy and cannot tolerate wickedness or look at evil. God answers the prophet a second time, and instructs him to record His answer for others to read it also. God's answer is that the "righteous shall live by faith." These words should be read in light of the New Testament to be fully understood. Those who have been justified by their faith in Jesus Christ are granted a spiritual life that they live by, here and now. This spiritual life will reach its fulfillment with the return of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, when all injustice, evil and wickedness will cease and true justice, truth and peace will prevail.
