Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(Ephesians 1:1-14)

In this letter to the church in Ephesus, the apostle starts by explaining how God has blessed the believers through Christ. God from before the foundation of the world had a plan for the salvation of humans. He has **chosen** us to be saved through Jesus Christ and **adopted** us as His children. We were chosen not just for salvation, but also for **holy living** (Vv.3-6). The chosen and adopted believers were forgiven their sins and **redeemed** (redemption in the Bible usually means release from slavery by the payment of a ransom) through the blood of Jesus (Vv.7-12). Finally God put His mark on the believers by **sealing** (In the ancient world the seal was the personal sign of the owner) them with the Holy Spirit (Vv.13, 14).
