### **Synopsis of the Armenian Message**

(Ephesians 1:15-23)

In verse 15 two qualities that marked the Ephesian church are mentioned. First, they had **faith** in Jesus. More than passive belief, more than reciting a creed, or an intellectual assent to certain facts, this meant complete trust. Second, their faith was demonstrated by **love** for the saints (the word "saint" in Scripture does not refer to some super-spiritual giant, but to every Christian). In verses 16-19 three specific things that every Christian needs to know when praying are mentioned. The **hope** He has given us, the **glory** that He shares with us, and His **power** that is available to us. In verses 20-23 we are reminded of three facts about Christ: He was **raised** from the dead, He was made to **sit** in heavenly places, and He is **head** over the church.
