Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(Ephesians 2:1-10)

Changed lives bear witness to our Lord's power. **I.** The Lord's power is visible through our **past** predicament when we lived in the flesh. The Ephesians were dead through their sins. The result of this was, no fellowship with God. Sins separate us from Him. **II.** The Lord's power is visible in the **present**. God is the one who changed things. He made new life possible. No longer dead in sin, we are raised to new life in Christ. Our new life comes from God, not by our works but by His grace. **III.** The Lord's power is visible by the **future** promise. The promise has two parts: what God shows and what we show. He shows the riches of His grace. Salvation is the gift of His love. We show our good works. We are not saved by our good works, but our good works will reflect our new relationship.
