Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(Ephesians 4:11-16)

In this section of the letter the Apostle Paul moves to discuss how God provides His church with leaders who will lead His people to maturity in the faith. He starts by listing those leaders and he mentions apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers. God has given leaders in the church special gifts, not for their own good, but for the good of the church body. Church leaders are to train and help believers be better at putting their faith into action through service, and to help the body of believers grow and be built up in the faith. As the believers grow spiritually, their unity and their knowledge of the Savior, Jesus Christ, will be strengthened, and they will become mature Christians. The spiritual maturity of the believers will allow them to stand against unbiblical doctrines and teachings that might come along.

Friends may we all strive to grow and be built up in our faith as to become a united, loving and mature body of Christ.
