Synopsis of the Armenian message

(Ephesians 5:22-6:4)

As we continue studying this letter, we come to these verses that discusses God's plan for the family. **The Wife's Role** (Vs. 22-24). The wife is to submit to her husband, not because he is superior to her, or more capable, or for any other reason, but simply because God, who created them both, had established a certain order for the well-being of the family unit. **The Husband's Role** (Vs. 25-33). Husbands are to love their wives as much as Christ loved His church. Christ loved the church to the point of giving His life for it. The husband must love his wife so much that he would be willing to die for her. His role calls for sacrificial self-giving and understanding. **The Child's Role** (Vs. 6:1-3). Children are to obey their parents. This is what God expects from them. Paul is not saying that parents are infallible. But that they have experience that can help the child. Parents also have responsibility to God for their children. **The Parent's Role** (V. 6:4). Parents are to be understanding towards their children, and to be responsible for their godly upbringing.

Notice that in each case, there are reciprocal duties. You cannot isolate one person's responsibility from the other's response. In order to have peace, harmony, and love at home, and in order for a family to function the way God intended it to, we need to follow His design and plan for the home.
