Synopsis of the Armenian message

(Ephesians 6:10-20)

After speaking of the greatness of the purpose of God in Christ, the glory of the high calling, and the life that should flow from it, Paul reminds his readers that such a life cannot be lived without spiritual battles.

The Enemy (Vv. 11-12). The Bible teaches that our enemy is the devil. Satan does not wear a red suit and carry a pitchfork. Instead, he moves in a cunning and crafty way. The Protection (Vv. 14-17a). The Christian's protection is compared to the armor of the Roman soldier. The believer's defensive preparation for the conflict with Satan includes: the belt of truth, the breastplate of righteousness, the sandals of peace, the shield of faith, and the helmet of salvation. The Weapon (Vv. 17b-20). Even the protective elements have an offensive nature: truth captivates; righteousness witnesses; peace gives time and energy; faith overcomes the world; and salvation takes you into the enemy's camp to set prisoner's free. The Victor (Vv.10, 11, 13). Victory is for those who overcome (Revelation 2:7, 11, 17). Overcomers are conquerors. To overcome, one must fight. We battle best as we pray most. The secret of victory lies in Christ's power alone. May we all trust in Christ's power for the victory.
