Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(James 1:1-8)

In this passage the apostle says that we should rejoice when we face trials. None of us like to go through difficult times, but we all know that it is inevitable. It is just part of life. So what should we do and how should we respond in the face of suffering. (1) Respond positively (v. 2), instead of responding with anger or resignation, rejoice for the growth that can come out of difficult times. (2) Respond productively (vv. 3,4), let trouble help you develop patience, perseverance, and maturity. (3) Respond prayerfully (v. 5), when you are going through a difficult time, go to God in prayer and ask Him to give you wisdom to face your troubles. If you want to see what's in a sponge – just squeeze it. The contents will reveal themselves under pressure. The same thing will happen to you.
