Synopsis of the Armenian Message

A man had a sign on his door which said, "Lead me not into temptation, I can find it for myself." That is a very true statement for all of us. James in this passage discusses temptations and says, (1) God does not tempted humans to do any evil. God may test our faith, but He Himself can neither be tempted by evil nor does He tempt anyone. (2) Temptations are a result of our inner lustful desires that eventually lead to sin. (3) Sin brings death. Adam and Eve brought physical death on themselves and all of humanity by giving in to their temptation, but sin results in spiritual death also. To be sure, temptations in themselves are not sin (Jesus was tempted), but acting upon them is sin. Let us all check our inner selves to make sure that all our thoughts and desires are pure and holy. And in moments of fierce temptation, let us call on God to give us strength to expel all evil and sinful thoughts and desires.
