Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(James 1:19-27)

In this section of the letter, the apostle deals with our attitude towards the Word of God. All of us have been in conversations where while the other person was talking we were thinking of what we will be saying next and so, did not hear what they were saying to us. To really hear a person we need to be really listening.

As to our attitude concerning God's Word, the apostle says that we should not only listen to it and then go away and forget it, but that we should listen and do what it says. Listening to the Word is important, but if we do not put it into action it remains only head knowledge. God has given us His Word to change our lives and unless we do what we hear there will be no change. Many people listen to God's Word Sunday after Sunday, yet they get nothing out of it because they are not willing to obey it. In verse 25, we are told that obedience to the Word brings blessing. Friends, if you want to see real change in your life, stop just listening, and start obeying God's Word.
