Synopsis of the Armenian Message

In the previous section (13:13-17), James contrasted two kinds of wisdom, worldly and heavenly. In this section, he continues with that theme and points out that this worldly wisdom (here in verse 4 he calls it friendship with the world) is in opposition to God. Those who choose love and friendship with the world become enemies of God. This friendship with the world is characterized by pride, selfish ambition, craving for pleasure, lust for material possessions, competing against each other, and desires that are always struggling to be satisfied. The result of all this is fights, quarrels, strife, divided and unhappy homes, marriages, and even churches.

What ought people who find themselves in this kind of situation do? **Repent.** In verses 7-10, James gives us some steps for true repentance. **Submit** yourself to God. **Resist** the devil. **Draw** near to God. **Wash** your hands. **Purify** you heart. **Humble** yourself before the Lord.

Friends, let us follow these steps that can help us become friends with God, who in turn will give us His grace to live lives pleasing to Him (heavenly wisdom).
