Synopsis of the Armenian Message

In these few simple verses (Luke 2:1-7) we have the birth of the Lord of this universe, the King of Kings, told. When we look closely at this passage, we see God's hand once again directing the events of history. Joseph and Mary travel to Bethlehem to register their names, and at that exact time the baby is born, in fulfillment of Micah's prophecy (Micah 5:2). But what we see more than anything is God's love displayed in this simple birth narrative. Jesus is God's love displayed to us. The Scriptures tell us (John 3:16) that it is God's love for us that brought Jesus to the world. God was reaching out to us. Jesus is God's instrument of salvation. We are also told that there was no room in the inn for Him because Bethlehem was crowded. This raises the question, what about our lives? Is your life so crowded that there is no room for Jesus? Salvation comes by making room for Jesus in our hearts.

I pray that this Christmas you will make room for the Savior in your life. Allow Him to come in, cleanse you from sin, and take up residence in your heart.
