# Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(Luke 4:1-13)

Following His baptism and before the official start of His ministry, Jesus went into the desert for a period of fasting and testing. At the end of the forty days when Jesus was hungry Satan comes to Him with his threefold temptation. The first temptation had to do with His hunger. Satan suggested that Jesus listen to him and abuse His power to turn the stones into bread. The second temptation had to do with possessions. Jesus is offered a shortcut to lordship over the kingdoms of the world through worship of Satan instead of through the cross. The third temptation had to do with testing God. Satan, quoting Scripture, challenges to perform a spectacular public stunt. In reply to the three temptations, Jesus uses God's Word (the sword of the Spirit) to respond and repulse Satan.

We too face temptations to feed our hunger for power, prestige, and possessions, to seek fame, to draw attention to ourselves, and put God to the test. The answer to all these temptations is God's Word. The more we study it and meditate on it, the more we will be equipped to resist temptations. Pray and ask God to strengthen you in the face of temptations.
