Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(1 Peter 1:13-2:3)

After speaking of the believer's glorious salvation in verses 3-12, here Peter turns his attention to the believer's conduct. First, we are to be holy just like God and because of Him. This means that our lives should be characterized by godliness and holiness. We are to imitate God in our behavior and not the world. Second, we are to live as strangers in this world. This means that we are to be different, and we are to remember that we are simply traveling through this world. Third, we are to love our brothers and sisters in the Lord sincerely and deeply. Those who have been born a new by God are to have a special love for one another. Fourth, we are to rid ourselves from all "malice, deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and slander" that produce ungodliness. Instead, because we "have tasted that the Lord is good," we are to crave pure spiritual food.
