Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(1 Peter 3:7-9)

In verses 1-6, Peter discussed wives relationships to their husbands, in verse 7 he turns to the husbands and addresses their responsibilities towards their wives. Husbands are to be "considerate and are to treat their wives with respect." This means that husbands are to be sensitive to their wives needs and respect them as equals. The reasons for this command are, (1) the wives are the "weaker partner." The weakness here is physical and not spiritual, and also he is not suggesting in any way that the wives are inferior to their husband, something the Bible never teaches. (2) Wives are equally "heirs of God's gracious gift of life." Believing husbands and wives have equal standing before God. (3) Discord and strife in a family disrupts their prayer life. Their discord hinders their relationships with God.

Husbands and wives, to maintain peace and harmony at home, respect each other, be considerate toward one another, pray together, always keep the lines of communication open, be united in your decisions, and last but not least, love each other. Love is a command and it covers a multitude of sins.
