### **Synopsis of the Armenian Message**

(1 Peter 4:7-11)

This section of Peter's letter is a series of admonitions to believers who were under intense persecution. He begins by reminding them that the end of time is getting near so they need to, (1) be clear-minded and self-controlled so that they could pray without fear or distraction. (2) Have a special, deep love for their brothers and sisters in the fellowship of the believers. Love does not take away the penalty and guilt of sin, which only the blood of Jesus can do, but love can help us overlook faults and failures in other believers. (3) Offer hospitality. A good way to express love towards other believers is through being hospitable during times of persecution when some in the fellowship might not have enough. (4) Use your God-given gifts for the good of the fellowship. God has gifted each believer with gifts that are to be used to serve and bless others in the fellowship. If the gift is preaching and teaching the Word of God, the person speaking should make sure that his words are the words God wants him to speak. If the gift has to do with any kind of serving, the person serving should recognize that God empowers him. This is so that God might be praised and glorified.
