Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(Micah 2:1-13)

In chapter one of this book, God, through the prophet Micah, pronounces punishment on Israel and Judah. In this chapter (vv.1-2) we are told the reasons for this coming punishment: greed, injustice, inequality, and the savage exercise of power for power's sake are shown as a result of a nation turning away from the Lord. "Woe to those who plan iniquity, to those who plot evil on their beds! At morning's light they carry it out because it is in their power to do it. They covet fields and seize them, and houses, and take them. They defraud a man of his home, a fellowman of his inheritance." Against such wickedness the prophet says, "Therefore, the Lord says: 'I am planning disaster against this people from which you cannot save yourselves. You will no longer walk proudly, for it will be a time of calamity" (v.3). (V.6-7), The people told Micah not to prophecy such unpleasant things because those things will not happen. (Vv. 8-11), by their sins the people have become like enemies of God, so they are told to, "get up, go away! For this is not your resting place, because it is defiled, it is ruined, beyond all remedy." (Vv. 12-13), the chapter ends with a promise. After the judgment God will gather the remnant from exile and restore them.

Friends, God will punish the sin of greed, injustice, selfishness, and abuse of power. Living in a society that is focused on personal pleasure, the amassment of money and stuff, how are you doing personally?
