LEADER: Gracious God, we pray that we might trust your promise of forgiveness in a time of personal guilt.

PEOPLE: **Gracious God, we pray that we might trust your promise of victory in a time of crushing failure.**

LEADER: Lord God, we pray that we might trust your promise of eternal life in a time of fading life.

PEOPLE: **Lord God, we pray that we might trust your promise of a promised land in a time of doubt.**

LEADER: Our loving Father, help us not give up on the promises but use the trying times to build faith and trust in your word.
