Synopsis of the Armenian Message

(I Thessalonians 2:1-12)

At the beginning of this second chapter of the Letter to the Thessalonians, Paul, reviews his ministry and lifestyle. As for his ministry (vv. 1-4), first, it was successful. The converted believers themselves are the evidence. Second, his ministry was courageous. Despite strong opposition that might have discouraged someone else, Paul, with God's help he went-on proclaiming the gospel. Third, his ministry was a sacred stewardship. God who had also entrusted him with the gospel approved him. As for his lifestyle (vv. 5-12), first, his words were honest and transparent, and his motives were pure. Second, he was not motivated by greed on the contrary he worked to support himself and not to be a burden to them. Third, God and they themselves were witnesses to his righteous behavior and holy life among them. Here is a preacher whose walk matched his words. His life was a sermon to them. Forth, he was gentle with his exhortation to them. He encouraged, comforted and urged them to live lives worthy of God's calling.

Friends, for Christ's followers (disciples) character is everything. Our character speaks much louder than words before the watching eyes of the world. How are you doing in that area?
