### **Synopsis of the Armenian Sermon**

(II Thessalonians 2:1-12)

In this section of the letter, the apostle Paul undertakes to correct a false rumor about the coming of Jesus and the Day of the Lord. It seems that some rumor had been circulating that Paul had said that the Day of the Lord had come. Paul denies the rumor's attribution to him, and that the Day of the Lord had arrived. He says that it is impossible for the Day of the Lord to have come because there are certain events that must first occur. First the "rebellion" must occur. This could mean a time of general opposition to God and rejection of the Christian faith. Second, the "man of lawlessness" must be revealed. The leader of this rebellion is going to be an impostor and an instrument of Satan. (v.8) Jesus' appearing will put an end to the "lawless one."

Friends, there is much that we can speculate about concerning the identity of the Antichrist and the exact date of the Day of the Lord, but what is more important is to focus on Christ, and "to love the truth and so be saved" (v.10).
