Synopsis of the Armenian Sermon

(II Thessalonians 3:6-18)

In this final section of the letter, Paul turns his attention to the issue of idleness or disorderly conduct. It seems that some people in the church had either stopped working at all, or were pretending to be very busy when in reality they were not involved in a legitimate work. These people were doing this because they believed that the return of Jesus was imminent that there was no reason to be engaged in any work. But the problem was that as they waited for the Lord's return, they were living off other members of the church. Paul instructs them to stay away from lazy people and to follow his example. He himself, even though entitled to help as a visiting missionary, had not relied on it when he was among them but had "labored and toiled very hard so that he would not be a burden on anyone." His rule to them was, "If a man will not work, he shall not eat."

Friends, this passage seems strange to us for we have gone to the total opposite extreme. We are so busy with our work that often we do not have time to think about God or to attend to our spiritual needs. Never mind the business of heaven. Surely the answer is somewhere in between. According to Jesus in Matthew 25, we are to be watchful while we are busy doing our work.
