Synopsis of the Armenian Sermon

Psalm 23 is a comfort psalm. It is the best-loved, best-known and most memorized psalm. Charles Spurgeon called it, "The pearl of the Psalms." (V.1) David who was a shepherd and very familiar with the responsibilities of a shepherd, says that God has chosen to be our personal shepherd. The great God of the universe has stooped down to take care of you and me. When the Almighty God, the Creator of everything is taking care of us, we will lack nothing. (V.2) We will not lack rest. When the Bible talks about rest, it is always spiritual rest first. Jesus said, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest... and you will find rest for your souls" (Mt. 11:28-30). (V.3) We will not lack life. The Lord provides forgiveness and restoration for those who follow Him. He makes us a new creation. (V.3) We will not lack guidance. Sheep are animals who easily wonder away, and a good shepherd knows the right paths to lead the sheep home. We also are like sheep easily led astray, but if we truly belong to the Great Shepherd, He will guide us in His righteous ways. (V.4) We will not lack safety. In life we will sometimes find ourselves in a valley of deep darkness, life is not always a mountain-top-experience. It is in the valleys with their trials and dangers that we develop character. We do not need to fear for the Lord is with us and will protect us. (V.5) We will not lack provisions. If we allow the Lord to lead us, we will find that just as the shepherd provides for the needs of the sheep, the Lord will provide for all our needs also. (V.6) The response of faith. After listing all the blessings of the Lord, David wanted to be in the presence of the Lord forever.

Friends, in the New Testament Jesus identified Himself as the "Good Shepherd" who lays His life for His sheep (Jn. 10:14-15). If our "Good Shepherd" is willing to give His life for us, wouldn't He also provide for all our spiritual and physical needs? I invite you to come and enter the care of the "Good Shepherd" by submitting yourself to Him.
