Synopsis of Armenian Sermon

(Psalm 100)

Psalm 100 is a beautiful psalm of praise that has been used in congregational singing from the days of temple worship. The psalm starts with a call to worship. This worship is to be universal and joyful. The whole earth should joyfully shout and worship the Lord. Two reasons why the whole earth (all people) and not just Israel should worship the Lord: (1) "The LORD is God. It is he who made us and we are his." The Lord is the Creator of us all. There is but one God and Creator of all people. It does not matter whether people today believe in a Creator or not, or whether they believe in the existence of God or not. The fact is that God created us all and everything else that exists. As Christians we worship Him because He is the living, active God who has revealed Himself to us in His Word. (2) "For the LORD is good and his love endures forever." The second reason we are to worship God is because He is a good God who loves us. John Stott says, "The Lord is not only great, but *good* (v 5). There is grounds to praise him not only for what he has done, but for what he is." God's goodness to His people is evidenced by His faithfulness to His promises, and by His love that endures forever.

Friends, more than anywhere else, God's goodness, mercy, and faithfulness was made manifest on the cross of Calvary. "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son" (John 3:16). Next time you come to worship God, come with joy and thanksgiving.
