Synopsis of the Sermon

In verses (33-48), Jesus gives three examples of a higher righteousness for His followers. (1) To tell the truth without the need to support our words with swearing. (2) To not retaliate against evil. Jesus here is not teaching that there should not be just punishment for evil, but that His followers are not to take the law of revenge into their own hands. (3) To love our enemies. The love Jesus is talking about is the love that God shows all people even when they are His enemies. To love our enemies is not natural, it is a result of a life transformed by Jesus and indwelt by the Holy Spirit.

Friends, these teachings are hard teachings, yet Jesus expects a higher standard from His followers than what the world expects. The Bible teaches that there is nothing impossible with God. Ask Him to help you be the Christian He expects you to be.
