PASTOR: But when you help a needy person, do it in such a way that even your closest friend will not know about it.

PEOPLE: And your Father, who sees what you do in private, will reward you.

PASTOR: And when your pray, do not be like the show-offs! They love to stand up and pray in the synagogues and on the street corners so that everybody will see them. Remember this! They have already been paid in full.

PEOPLE: But when you pray, go to your room and close the door, and pray to your Father, who is unseen. And your Father, who sees what you do in private, will reward you.

PASTOR: In your prayers do not use a lot of words, as the pagans do, who think that God will hear them because of their long prayers. Do not be like them; your Father already knows what you need before you ask him.

PEOPLE: And when you fast, do not put on a sad face like the show-offs do. They go around with a hungry look so that everybody will be sure to see that they are fasting. Remember this! They have already been paid in full.

PASTOR: When you go without food, wash your face and comb your hair,

PEOPLE: So that others cannot know that you are fasting, only your Father, who is unseen, will know. And you Father, who sees what you do in private, will reward you.

Synopsis of the Armenian Sermon

Peter begins his second letter with the traditional salutation of the believers who he acknowledges as possessing the same faith he does. This faith he says is a gift from God and based on the righteousness of Jesus purchased on the cross of Calvary. He goes on to say that when God calls people to faith in Jesus, He gives them everything they need to live godly lives. And what they need is a growing knowledge of Jesus. This knowledge grows when the believer makes the effort to develop a strong Christian character. Some of the qualities that he mentions include: faith, goodness, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly kindness, and love. "For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ" (v.8).

Friends, to come to faith in Jesus Christ is one part of the salvation process and it is to be followed by an increasing growth in Christlikness. Are you growing in your knowledge of Jesus?
