Synopsis of the Armenian Sermon

(2 Peter 2:1-10a)

In this section of his letter, Peter turns his attention to the issue of false prophets (teachers). At the end of chapter one he had said that the Old Testament prophets did not prophecy of their own will, but as they were moved by the Holy Spirit. Now he adds that there always were false teachers and there always will be. These false teachers often pose as real ministers of the gospel, but introduce false and destructive teachings. They carry their Bibles and use biblical expressions, vet they use them to mean something entirely different. These false teachers are motivated by financial and sexual greed, and they exploit their followers through made up stories. Because of their deception, condemnation and destruction is awaiting them. In verses 4-10, Peter gives three Old Testament examples of apostasy - the angels, Noah's flood, and Sodom and Gomorrah. The angels mentioned here are most likely the ones mentioned in Jude 6 and Genesis 6 called "sons of God." They sinned by not keeping their position and proper dwelling. In Noah's time God decided to punish man because "The LORD saw how great man's wickedness on the earth had become, and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil all the time" (Genesis 6:5). God also condemned the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah for their wicked sin. But, Peter says, this same God who judges the sinner, also rescues the righteous as in the case of Lot.

Friends, we live in a society that has been forcing us to accept immoral and sinful practices as normal. False teachers who call themselves Pastors and Bishops falsely teach that God's Word does not condemn these sinful practices. What to do? Know God's truth, care about the truth, and lovingly confront the world with the truth.
