Synopsis of the Armenian Sermon

(2 Peter 3:8-13)

In this section of his letter, the apostle Peter continues dealing with the issue of the "scoffers" who ridiculed the idea of the second coming of Christ and the judgment associated with it. After rebuking them, he turns to the faithful Christians and addresses them. The reason why God is delaying His judgment of the world is not because God is being unfaithful to His promises, but because;

- 1. God is timeless. God does not live in a sphere of time as we do and we cannot interpret God's timetable by our human reckoning of time.
- 2. God is patient. God does not want any person to perish. He desires that all persons repent and be saved.

Peter ends his argument by reminding his readers to be watchful for the day of the Lord will come unexpectedly. And since they do not know when that day will come, therefore they ought to be careful about how they live their lives. He says, "You ought to live holy and godly lives as you look forward to the day of God ..." (v.11-12).

Friends, the Bible teaches that Jesus' return is imminent, yet the Bible does no set an exact date. What the apostle Peter is telling us here is that we should be more concerned about how we live our lives than knowing the exact day that Jesus will return. Are you living a holy and godly life?
