Synopsis of the Armenian Message

In Damascus, Saul is welcomed into the homes of the disciples and was allowed to preach at the local synagogue. Those who heard him preach were astonished at the radical change that they saw in Saul. He was known as a radical persecutor of Christ's followers, but now he "baffled the Jews living in Damascus by proving that Jesus is the Christ" (22). Because of his preaching he became the target of an assassination plan. His followers helped him escape and he traveled to Jerusalem. Saul's arrival in Jerusalem presented the church with a sever test to its openness towards radical converts. Initially, Saul was left waiting on the sidelines until the church could determine that his conversion was real and that he can be trusted. But Barnabas steps in and becomes the go-between person to introduce Saul to the church and speaks persuasively on his behalf. Barnabas whose name means "Son of Encouragement," had recognized the transforming power of Christ in the life of Saul and also recognized the potential this young man can have for the cause of Christ.

Friend's, the church needs more bighearted people like Barnabas who will introduce "outsiders" to the church. Is there someone that you can be a Barnabas to?
