# Synopsis of the Armenian Message

King Herod Agrippa I was a wicked manipulator. He had manipulated the Romans and the Jews for his advantage. When he saw that persecuting the church pleased the Jews, he proceeded to arrest some of the leaders of the church. Peter is arrested and put in prison. God miraculously saves him. James, the brother of John is arrested and put to death. We cannot adequately explain why the same powerful God saves one and allows the other to die; all we can say is that as Christians we are called to remain faithful to Jesus no matter how things turn out for us. As for Herod, the reality of God's justice and judgment eventually catches up with him and the angel of the Lord strikes him down (23).

Friends, men may have their plans and they might play their little games in this life, but ultimately everyone will be accountable to the sovereign Lord. As Christians we are to glorify Christ whether by life or death.
