Synopsis of the Armenian Message

As Paul and Silas continue their missionary journey, they experience God's guidance in a "negative" and "positive" ways. Three times God alters their plans. The Holy Spirit prevents them from preaching in the province of Asia, the Spirit of Jesus prevents them from entering Bithynia, and God changes their plans to preach in Troas. Positively, God guides them to go to Macedonia to preach the gospel. It is interesting to notice that Paul and his companions are receptive to God's guidance and when they followed His guidance, God also brought positive results with the conversion of Lydia and her household. It is a good reminder to us that since it is God's mission, God is to be the focus of it, and the One to give direction.

Friends, God sometimes uses "negative" and "positive" guidance to direct our lives also. Sometimes God closes doors that we are trying to open, and opens other doors for us. May we all be as receptive and obedient to God's guidance in our lives as Paul and his companions were.
