## **Synopsis of the Armenian Message**

While waiting for Timothy and Silas in Athens, Paul was burdened by the idolatry that he saw in this great city of culture, education and fine arts. As usual, Paul began to preach in the synagogue and the market place. Soon he came in contact with some Greek philosophers who were always interested in the latest ideas and who invited him into their meeting to learn more about what he was preaching and teaching. Paul uses an inscription under one of their idols that read, "TO UN UNKNOWN GOD" as his point of contact with this gentile audience and proceeded to make known to them the God that they did not know. These people who are very "religious" yet ignorant, Paul says should know that: (1) God is a creator God, "The God who made the world and everything in it is the Lord of heaven and earth." (2) He is a caring God, "He himself gives all men life and breath and everything else." (3) He is controlling God, "From one man he made every nation of men... and he determined the times set for them and the exact places where they should live." (4) God is a close God, "He is not far from each one of us." (5) God is a compassionate God, "He commands all people to repent." (SU). Paul adds in closing that God has set a day when He will judge the world. Most of those who heard Paul's sermon scoffed at him, but few believed.

Friends, God has made Himself perfectly known through His Word and His Son Jesus Christ who is the full revelation of the Father. The question is how well do you know the known God?
