Synopsis of the Armenian Message

In these verses we have Paul's final emotionally charged meeting with the elders of the church of Ephesus. Here are the main points of his farewell address to them,

- 1. "You know how I lived the whole time I was with you." He practiced what he preached.
- 2. "I served the Lord with great humility and with tears." He was marked by true humility.
- 3. "I have declared to both Jews and Greeks that they must turn to God in repentance and have faith in our Lord Jesus. He preached salvation by faith in Jesus Christ to all.
- 4. "In every city the Holy Spirit warns me that prison and hardships are facing me." No suffering was too great for the cause of the gospel.
- 5. "I have not hesitated to proclaim to you the whole will of God." He has preached the whole gospel faithfully.
- 6. "Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood." He wants the elders also to be good and faithful shepherds over the precious church that's entrusted to their care.

Pray that God will give you the same love and passion for Jesus Christ and His gospel that Paul had.
