Synopsis of the Armenian Message

Paul had been warned not to travel to Jerusalem because he will be arrested and handed over to the authorities. Paul’s answer was, “I am ready not only to be bound, but also to die for the name of Jesus.” Well, soon after he arrived in Jerusalem and while he was in the temple, some Jews from Asia Minor recognized him and stirred a crowd that seized him and tried to kill him. As the Roman authorities in charge of security rescued him from the hands of the crowd, the crowd kept shouting, “Away with him!” This sounds very much like what the crowd shouted when they brought Jesus before Pilate (Jn 19:15).

Friends, today also many want to do away with the Christian faith and its influence in our society. Christianity stands at odds with the world and its teaching of throwing away the yoke of religion and living a liberated life without any restrictions. Ask God to give you and all of us the strength and courage to stand firm in the faith.
