Synopsis of the Armenian Message

In the final chapter of this story, Boaz goes to the gate of the city where legal matters were settled to do what he promised Ruth he will do. It so happened that while Boaz was standing there the closer kinsmenredeemer walked by. Boaz gives the closer relative the chance to buy back the land belonging to Elimelech. The relative seems to be willing to do that until he is told that he also would have to marry Ruth. That complicates the matter for him and he backs away. The refusal of the closer relative to marry Ruth frees Boaz, who was next in line, to marry her. The story concludes with Boaz marrying Ruth and God blessing their marriage with a son, Obed. Naomi who had earlier said that God took her full to Moab and brought her back empty, now feels God's blessing again as she holds the baby and cares for him as her own. In her darkest hour she could never have imagined that things will turn out this way - but God had His own plans that He was working out in her life. The concluding genealogy at first appears to be an unnecessary addition to this beautiful story, but at close examination we find out that this baby was the grandfather of David, the greatest king of Israel, and the ancestor of David's great Son, our Lord Jesus Christ (Matthew 1).

Friends, when you are going through a dark hour in your life do not despair. You might not be able to see God's big picture at the time, but still trust Him to use your dark hour to bring out something good.
