Synopsis of the Armenian Message

In verses 10-16, Malachi addresses the issue of marital faithfulness. Verse 10 consists of three questions that introduce the problem. In verse 11, he says that Judah (i.e. the people who live in Judah) has broken faith and desecrated God's sanctuary by marrying "daughters of a foreign god." In the Old Testament God clearly prohibited His people from intermarrying with people who worshiped other gods. The prohibition was based on religious not racial grounds. It seems that whenever a worshiper of God married a person from another religion, they ended-up either with divided loyalties or they totally abundant God to follow the pagan gods of their spouses. Solomon is a good example of this (1 Kings 11:1-8). Christians who marry non-believers face the same problem, and for that reason, Paul also addresses this issue in the New Testament (2 Corinthians 6:14).

In verses 13-15, Malachi points out to another serious problem, the problem of unfaithfulness in the marriage relationship. The people were wondering why God has stopped accepting their offerings. The answer is that they were breaking their marriage vows. Notice in verse 14 he says that marriage is: (1) a covenant not a contract or an agreement or something else, (2) that God is the witness of that covenant, and (3) that the wife is a partner in the marriage relationship. Being unfaithful to the marriage covenant is displeasing to God. God desires healthy marriages that are necessary for healthy families.

In verses 15-16, Malachi says that God had intended His people to be one pure people, introducing "godly offspring." Unfaithfulness often leads to divorce, and God says that He hates divorce. So the prophet urges them to be vigilant and to guard themselves and not break faith.

Friends, these are strong but timely words to us about how God sees marriage, and what He expects from married couples. How is your marriage? What are you doing to guard your marriage?
