Synopsis of the Messages

We all have a lot of interesting ideas about "church." A lot of people think of "church" as an area of life. Jesus and the New Testament writers always used pictures, or metaphors when they talked about the church to communicate what they were envisioning.

- A "body." The living expression of Christ on Earth; Jesus is the "head" and we are the various "members," and we each have a role to play in the functioning of this "body." The "church" is a living, active body.
- A "bride." Specifically, the "bride of Christ."
- A "spiritual temple." Not a physical building, but a sort of spiritual building being built by God, each believer being a new 'stone' in the temple . . . and Jesus is the chief corner stone of the whole spiritual temple. The "church" is a spiritual house of sorts.
- A "family." The "church" is a family, with parents, adolescents and babies. People at all different stages of spiritual life living together in community with one another, helping one another along in the growth process.

The basic idea is that the "church" is a dynamic movement of changed lives. It is not a static organization, not a system, not a building on the corner, not a duty. The first one to use the term "church" was Jesus. And He said, "I will build My church, and the gates of hell won't be able to stop it." Right from the get-go He envisioned a force, a movement, an unstoppable power that would contend with evil.

The apostle Paul reminded one church of its fundamental purpose – "Do everything without grumbling or arguing, so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a warped and crooked generation. Then you will shine among them like stars in the sky as you hold firmly to the word of life" (Philippians 2:14-16).

Shine like stars in the midst of a dark generation. Let your light shine. **E.A.C.H.** dream was born in the hearts of Christian leaders who sensed we weren't throwing off enough light. In light of the trying times our region has been through these last few years, now is the time to let the love of Christ shine outward, through good deeds and good news. Jesus knows exactly what this region is going through. He knows the hardship of every single family, every individual. AND He knows what His churches are doing to respond to this time of need. This is a huge opportunity for the CHURCH in metro-Detroit to come together and really BE the CHURCH!
